LUNCHROOM RULES

1. Classes are to walk quietly in a line to the lunchroom. They are to go to their assigned table, as directed by the lunch supervisor.
2. Students are to remain seated quietly until it is their turn to get their lunches. Students purchasing milk only may proceed directly to the line to purchase the milk.
3. Students buying lunches are to walk to the lunch line at the direction of the lunch supervisor. These students are to WALK to the lunch line to purchase their lunch. Those children running in line, or misbehaving, will be seated by the lunch supervisor and will be served last.
4. Students are to get silverware, napkins, catsup, mustard, etc. while purchasing their lunch. They will not be allowed to get these items later without permission from the lunch supervisor.
5. Children are encouraged to use the washroom facilities BEFORE coming to the lunchroom.
6. Students are not allowed to leave the table for any reason without permission from the lunch supervisor. Students are to raise their hand and wait for permission from the lunch supervisor.
7. Students are responsible to keep their paper, refuse and food off the floor and not scattered on the table. They will be expected to clean up after themselves. Students will not be dismissed until their area is clean. Students must raise their hand and two fingers to signal the lunch supervisor that they need to throw away garbage. They are to wait for an "OK" from the lunch supervisor.
8. Students are to remain seated at all times while at the lunch table. They are not to stand, kneel on benches, or walk around.
9. Students will not be allowed to return to their classroom unless a lunch supervisor grants special permission. Classroom doors are locked when a teacher is not present.
10. Sharing of food by children during lunch is discouraged.
11. Students need to speak in soft voices in the lunchroom. Yelling shouting and talking loudly in the lunchroom are not permitted. If all students speak softly, this leads to a more pleasant environment for everyone.
12. Students are expected to follow the directions of the lunchroom supervisors.
13. Fast food is discouraged and cannot be brought into the lunchroom.
14. No soda pop.
15. No beverages in glass bottles or cans are allowed.

Students not following the above rules will be subject to disciplinary actions. Disciplinary actions will be considered based on the severity or repetitiveness of the offense and may include the following.

1. A verbal warning.
2. A written punishment.
3. Isolation in the lunchroom/isolation from recess.
4. Parent contact.
5. Assignment to in-school suspension.
